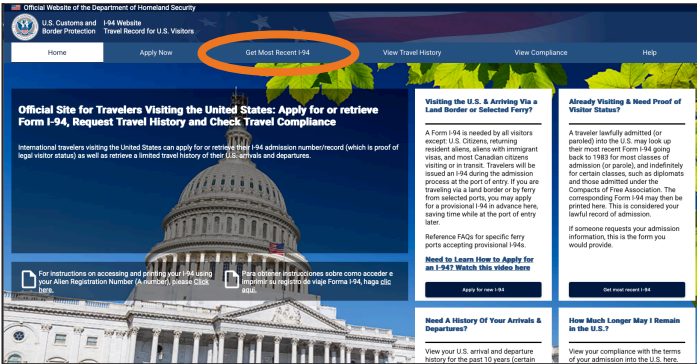
STEPS TO RETRIEVE YOUR I-94 ONLINE

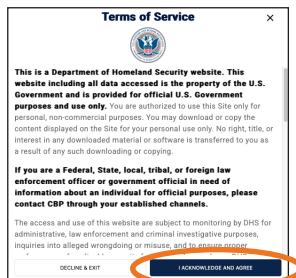
Since I-94s are now automated, you can retrieve your I-94 form on-line from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security website by following these simple steps:

- **Document Number:** This is your passport number. You will need to provide the number of the passport you used on your most recent entry into the United States, regardless if it is expired.



1 Visit the U.S. Customs and Border Protection website at <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/home>. Click on the "Get Most Recent I-94" button from the bar at the top of the page (circled in the screenshot above).

2 You will then see a "Terms of Service" window. Scroll to the bottom of this window until you can select the blue "I ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE" button (circled in the image at right). Click that button. You will then be taken to the "Enter Your Traveler Info" form.



3 On this form, fill in **all** information as follows:

- **Name:** Be sure to use the name as spelled out in your passport. If you changed your name while residing in the United States, please input the name on your passport and **not** your new name).
- **Last Name:** Be sure to use your last name as spelled out in your passport. If you change your last name while residing in the United States, please input the last name used on your passport and **not** your new last name.
- **Date of Birth:** Double-check to ensure that the date is correct and accurate.
- **Country of Citizenship:** Choose "Micronesia, Federated States of" from the drop-down menu.

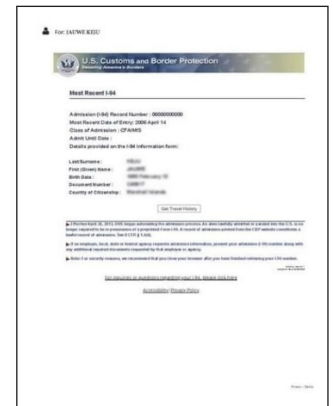

4 Once all information is entered, click on the "Continue" button at the bottom of the form (circled above). Your I-94 information will appear as in the sample at the right.



5 Print out this page for safekeeping.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The passport used at your most recent entry into the United State is the passport number you will input into the field "Document Number" on the form, regardless of its expiration date and how long you've been in the U.S. You will need to obtain this information if you don't have it.
- If you lost the passport used upon entry and you don't have the number, you may contact the FSM offices (Embassy and Consulates) anywhere in the U.S., and they can check for you in the existing immigration database.
- The Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) also has the ability to check the passport number you used to enter the United States. This step in the process will be explained later.
